The following letter is full of extremely important information and updates regarding the Career-Tech Center school schedule. Please read carefully and feel free to contact us with any questions you may have.

First things first: the CTC is returning to full time attendance for all students! Beginning Tuesday, February 16, we will return to our traditional five day-per-week schedule. This came as a result from vastly improved COVID-19 case numbers, all local districts returning to full time face-to-face instruction, and the availability of vaccines.

Please note next week, February 15-19, is a unique school week based on the majority of districts being closed Monday, February 15. In addition, the CTC will be closed to ALL students/districts for educator COVID vaccination clinics on Friday, February 19. Consequently, we will have a 'soft launch' of our return to the in-person school schedule Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday next week with the first full week beginning Monday, February 22.
