



# Regional Return to Learn Plan

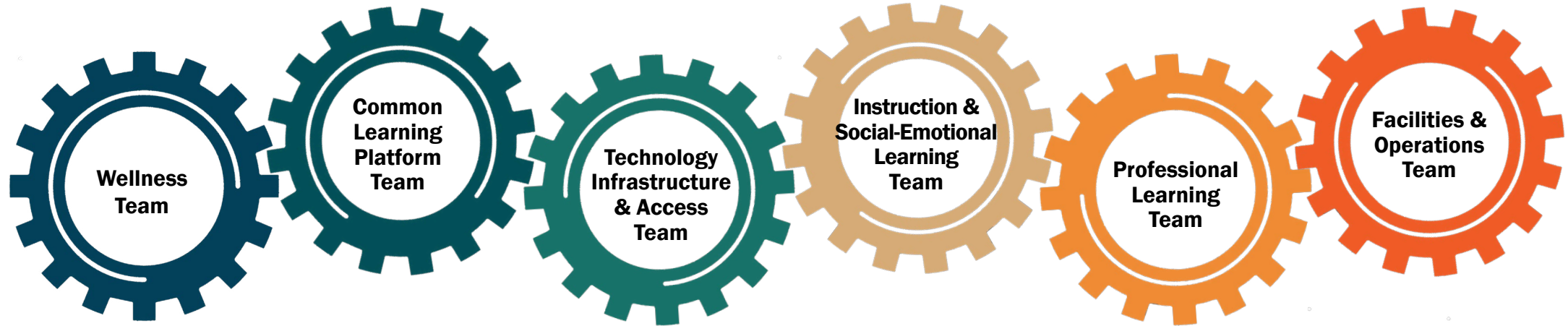
